*Background Information:* On June 26, 2000, the Duck Valley Reservation Shoshone-Paiute Tribes submitted a memo (attached file) requesting that Project Proposal 20094 entitled “Assess Resident Fish Stocks of the Owyhee Basin, D.V.I.R. Portion” be considered for funding through the RFC Placeholder. During the Project Proposal Review for Fiscal Year 2000, the proposal was categorized as Tier II (i.e., fund when money becomes available in the future) and received favorable reviews from the ISRP. The SPT seeks approval from the RFC so that the request can be forwarded to the Members Management Group for their July 6, 2000, meeting in Spokane, Washington.
