Discussion: Josh distributed the latest draft of the introductory Phase II document, titled “Run Characteristics, Current Distribution, and Efforts to Improve Passage of Adult Pacific Lamprey in the Columbia River Basin, 2011”. This draft included some revisions to a previous draft suggested by subgroup members.

The subgroup reviewed and discussed the draft document, and made recommendations for several changes. The subgroup decided that Willamette Falls should be included. Additional information on Columbia and Snake River dams will be provided by the USACE in the near future.

A new draft of the document will be ready shortly after the necessary information is provided.

At the subsequent meeting of the entire Lamprey Technical workgroup, a recommendation was made to include, in tabular or bullet form, a summary of what passage metrics have been measured at what projects, along with some detail on methods, procedures, and value.
